Hello Mohawkers!

This year we will be gathering in Branson, Missouri, for our annual reunion. As you see on the previous page, our dates this year are 11-14 October, which should be a great time to be in the Missouri Ozark mountains. The weather usually is very mild and the trees should be in full color.

The format for this year's reunion is a bit different, as your board of directors decided to try using a professional military reunion planning firm for 2012 to see how we like having someone else do the majority of the work and relieve your Reunion Director of some of the chores. We have chosen to work with Pam Brown, whose firm "Gatherings Plus" is a local Branson company specializing in organizing reunions for military veterans' groups.

You will soon be receiving a complete package of information and materials to register for this year's reunion. Once you receive your package via email or snail mail, be sure to make your room reservation if you have the remotest thought of coming to Branson, as space is limited and this area of Missouri is quickly becoming a very popular tourist destination all times of year. As usual room reservations are made direct with the hotel on an individual basis, and the hotel should honor the contracted Mohawk rate 3 days prior and post reunion if space allows. All materials required to register will be included in your package of information and this year the registration forms will be going to Gatherings Plus directly. Pam will handle all the registrations, make the nametags, keep track of who is coming (registered to come), sign us up for shows & meals, and all the other details before the reunion starts.

As you can see, Pam has laid out several popular added attractions with group ticket rates for our participation, and she has the ability to provide you with tickets to other shows if you would like to do more than what is listed on our itinerary. The shows and attractions on our itinerary are for you to choose from: you do NOT have to do all of them, but may pick and choose which ones you desire to attend. Last-minute additions to events will depend on space available on transport as well as in a theater, boat, etc. The rates shown are based on minimum participation of at least 20 people from our group.

Please, PLEASE get your room reservations and reunion registrations in as early as possible.

You should be aware of the two (2) airports, with similar names, which serve the Branson area. Branson Airport (BKG) is a fairly new, privately-financed and constructed commercial airport just southeast of town. This airport is served by Southwest Airlines and Frontier Airlines, and is the only airport to which the hotel shuttle will operate. Enterprise has the car rental concession here.

Springfield-Branson National Airport (SGF) is located about 45 miles away, west of Springfield, MO. It is served by American, Allegiant, Delta and United airlines. See www.flyspringfield.com for transportation info to Branson. All major car rentals are available here.
